BACKGROUND INFO:

Randolph Wingate was born into the prestigious Wingate Family of London, cultured and raised by his parents to carry on a life of political and social engagements. While he learned the value of social preparedness forced upon him, he also scoffed at his family's insistence of non-action in military and political matters.

Intrigued by his readings of WWII, he focused on the Double Cross system developed by MI5, the espionage and security sector of the government, in the 1930's. As the War began, MI5 put into implementation their highly-organized system of turning German agents into British double-agents to feed misleading intel back to the German command.

Ignoring the wishes of his family, Wingate joined MI5 in the fall of 1968, quickly gaining acclaim as an excellent field agent that followed his gut instincts. After being punished for not following his handler's orders, he left MI5 to become a founding member of the Agency in the middle of the Cold War. The handler mysteriously disappeared shortly after his transition, shadowed by rumors of secret-selling to the KGB.

Wingate values the lives of his men over any political bureaucratic prestige system, and has lately been a vocal contender to the Agency's seeming lack of morality.
