Thomas Lang was born in Miami, FL in 1980. Father was a City of Miami Police officer, mother was a CPA and tax attorney. Lang always had a knack for negotiation and was on debate team in high school. Upon graduation, Lang enrolled at the University of Miami in 1997 to study finance, planning to become an investment banker. Lang graduated in 2001, shortly after the 9/11 attacks and began working for Macgruder and Simms, a prominent international investment firm out of London. The following year, a co-worker of Lang's who served in the British Army reserves was killed while on assignment in the Balkans, spurring Lang to take a leave of absence and enroll in US Army Officer Candidate School. While there, Lang took an interest in Special Forces, due to his experience with European languages and his desire to fight terror. Upon completion of his SF training, Lang was promoted to Captain and assigned to the 10th Special Forces Group, 1st Battalion as an 18-A, Special Forces Officer. Lang and his team carried out operations all throughout Europe and Russia, most commonly pursuing arms dealers and local terrorist operations. Following one successful operation, Lang was approached by an undisclosed CIA officer and was recruited shortly thereafter. Lang was attached to CIA Special Activities Division (SAD) and was sent to a field office in Berlin as his first duty station. His established cover was Jeremy Roth, CEO of Vandalay Industries, an international private banker and financier. In reality, his entire staff was agency personnel and they were charged with infiltrating a Western-European terrorist network with ties to Al-Qaeda. In addition to planning and carrying out attacks, this group served as a support network for terrorists from Afghanistan and Iran, not only financing them through front companies and laundered drug money, but also aiding fugitive terrorists in escaping to the US. Roth had convinced local contacts for the cell that he was willing to provide logistical and financial support using his own very reputable international firm as a concrete cover. For the next several years, Vandalay Industries grew and grew its legitimate operations and Lang was on the verge of capturing the leadership of the terrorist cell, when a rogue element of his own team was caught, tortured, and ultimately revealed Lang and compromised their operation. Lang was immediately ferretted out of Germany for his own safety and was relocated to London, UK. He reached out to former allies from MI6, as his CIA handlers were keeping their distance. Lang's associate was only able to provide a card with a telephone number on one side and the name Scotch on the other. The rest is history.
