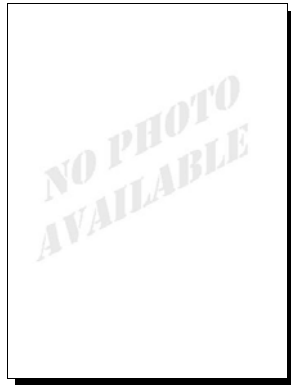

MISSION BRIEFING:

We have received some disturbing intelligence from sources in the Middle East. The Shahada terrorist group has apparently smuggled a nuclear warhead out of the old Soviet republic of Kazakhstan, and has it on a Turkish cargo ship headed for Israel, the Istanbul Voyager. We believe their plan is to detonate the warhead once they reach port in Tel Aviv. This is a long argued possible tactic for Anti-Israeli terrorists, called by military strategists the "Black Arrow Scenario." By striking Tel Aviv directly, this could easily be Israel's breaking point and throw the entire Middle East into total war.

We cannot let this happen. Your mission is to intercept the cargo ship in the Mediterranean Sea where the nuke cannot be a danger to the public. You can disable the warhead or simply take it off of the ship, but at all costs, it must not reach Tel Aviv. Be careful, we assume the warhead will be heavily guarded and, to further complicate matters, the ship's crew is still onboard and being held as hostages. MISSION DEBRIEFING:

Mission Completed: 4-22-07, 3:15AM Local Time

Team received orders and took Agency transport to Paphos, Cyprus. In flight, agents requested active keyhole satellite reconnaissance of the ship and formulated a tactical assault plan. Once at the airstrip in Cyprus, agents received their naval attack helicopter and waited for nightfall to launch their assault. The experimental audio sensor masking installed on the helicopter proved effective at allowing the team pilot's approach and landing to go unnoticed. The team sniper took out the guards above deck easily, but the team commander noticed these guards were armed with high military assault rifles. The team finished the sweep of the upper deck with no incident. Once inside the ship's lower decks, the agents split into two groups to assault the port and starboard side of the ship simultaneously. Dividing team members by native language proved to be an excellent idea, and the agents preserved their stealth through the majority of the ship. Eventually the enemy was alerted to their presence and heavy close-quarters combat ensued. The team found the warhead in the rear cargo bay, under the guard of a squad of elite soldiers in heavy armor and sporting more next-gen assault rifles. After frontal attacks failed, the team used a clever combination of smoke and thermal imaging to isolate the aggressors and secure the device. The crew thought to be under hostage was later discovered executed in their quarters, seemingly shot as they slept. Once the team returned safely with the device to Cyprus, Israeli naval forces were alerted to the vessel and scuttled it on open water.
