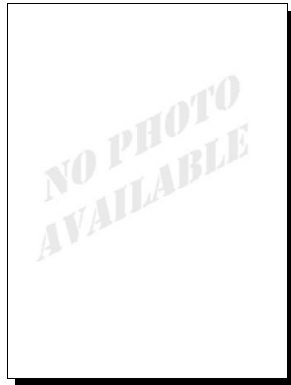

MISSION BRIEFING:

Greetings Agents. Six months ago, The Agency captured and detained a man named George Hevesy, who is a world-renowned scientist. His theories on bio-chemical fusion technology lead to a development so advanced and dangerous, he has been under the Agency guard for his own protection since. Now, this project, which he calls simply "Sunshine," may be in jeopardy. The security team assigned to him has missed its last check-in, 6PM yesterday, and cannot be raised. The secure location is just outside of Kitzbuhel, Austria, and satellite passes are useless due to heavy forest cover. We do not know what has happened, but for the good of the world this "Sunshine" research cannot fall into the hands of anyone else. Your mission is to go to Kitzbuhel, find out what has happened, find Dr. Hevesy, and make sure his research stays a well-guarded secret. Your team can leave as soon as you are ready. Hurry, the world as we know it could be at stake.

MISSION DEBRIEFING:

****Mission Completed: 1-17-09, 8:30 PM Local Time**** Team received intel and proceeded directly to Kitzbuhel. Immediately they encountered a large group of Shahada rebels at Dr. Hevesy's cabin, but were able to subdue them and retake the doctor alive. Surprisingly, the doctor revealed that Shahada was not the group responsible, but was under the command of Leo Sobec, a GENESIS member. The doctor also said his active proteins for the Sunshine project were stolen by Sobec, and were placed inside a tanker truck which had recently departed for Zurich. Dr. Hevesy was led to believe that Sobec intended to use Sunshine in a fusion explosion to blow up the financial center of Europe. By air and aground, the Agents found the tanker in Switzerland, and it was being driven by Ernesto Cortez, who was encountered on Scorpion Sting, and Jamil Thomas, an Agency contact was the passenger. The team assaulted the tanker driving on the autobahn, and was able to bring the vehicle to a stop without explosion, then interrogated Cortez and Thomas to get Sobec's location. Thomas revealed that the explosion was just a cover for a well-planned heist targeting the Swiss bank accounts via hack. He also gave the location. The team immediately moved to Zurich, and found Sobec, along with a group of heavily armored soldiers, and Simon Drexon, a suspected GENESIS connection who had previously infiltrated the Agency. A gunfight ensued, and the team was pinned for some time until one Agent managed to get behind and put a well-placed shotgun shell into the back of Drexon and kill him, essentially stopping the hack. Afterward, Sobec's men provided enough cover for him to escape and he was able to flee the city.
