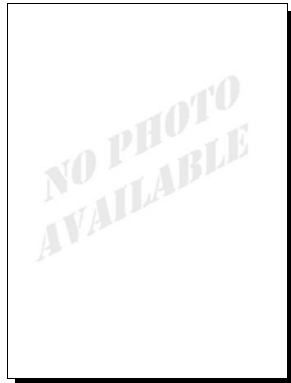

MISSION BRIEFING:

As you all know the agency uses contacts in a variety of different ways. One such contact, Jillian Inagua, was recruited to aid in a future mission involving illegal narcotics transactions and negotiations in and around the Florida Keys area and especially the Miami downtown and beach area. She was given vital information into the upcoming mission such as locations, dates and times along with some of the Agents who were to be assigned. MISSION DEBRIEFING:
