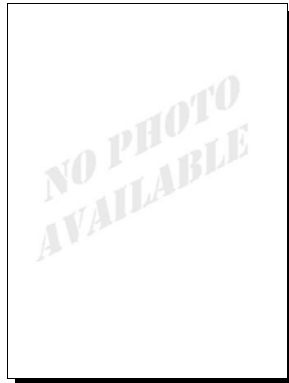

MISSION BRIEFING:

The Agency gathers Intel from various resources regarding possible acts of violence towards high profile individuals throughout the world. The rumor mill constitutes the bulk of this information with only a few leads producing real threats. One such operative that the Agency has been trying to keep tabs on for many years is a skilled assassin, who goes by the name of "The Triggerman". His orders are to kill one predetermined target every year on March 20th, which has been denoted as the "Day Of The Bullet". The Agency believes his newest target to be Stephen Bruinsma, a high-ranking executive of the (SFBA) Swiss Financial Bankers Association located in Zurich. Bruinsma is the chief financial executive that oversees funds for many privately funded European securities organizations. Your mission is to protect the target from becoming "The Triggerman's" next victim. Rendezvous with your contact at the designated time and place for further details.

MISSION DEBRIEFING:

Mission completed 1:15 pm on 3-20-09.

Agents made their way to Zurich where they rendezvoused with their contact for critical information on the target and the target location. A reconnaissance of the target location during the day was performed where Agents gathered Intel on the possible angles "The Triggerman" may attempt. A nighttime break-in was tried but with little success due to an overwhelming Swiss police force patrolling the area. The Agents decided to break up into three teams on the Day Of The Bullet and infiltrated key areas throughout the location posing as event medical staff, a SFBA member with bodyguard and museum employees. The team spotted "The Triggerman" who was disguised as a Swiss police officer on the lower grounds. One shot from "The Triggerman" was fired at the target that missed. The team successfully rescued the target from being assassinated by bull rushing him off the stage area. Knowing he had failed, "The Triggerman" turned the tables on some the Agents by persuading the Swiss police that they in fact were the threat while he tried to escape. Some counter persuasion attempts on behalf of the detained Agents help reveal his disguise, which led to "The Triggerman's" capture. "The Triggerman" was released to the Agents but died of an unknown poison while in transit back to the Agency. An autopsy and toxicology report were performed which still remains inconclusive.
