**MISSION BRIEFING:**

One of the Agency's deep cover operatives stationed in Ireland has broken protocol and sent a message to the agency directly. Three years ago this agent, code named Morrigan, was assigned to infiltrate the IRA and keep watch on their military operations and financial transactions. This encoded message is very short, only calling for an immediate meeting with an Agency contact to report important information. The message has been authenticated, so we're sending a team. Standard procedure is to contact Agents in their place of initial recruitment, and for Morrigan it was the Landmark Hotel in London, England. Your mission is to travel to London and meet with Morrigan, obtain any Intel she has, and if necessary, extract her. There is a reservation at the Hotel under the corporate name Comstar communications. Upon your arrival, Morrigan should contact you. Your flight leaves in 2 hours. Good luck.

**MISSION DEBRIEFING:**

Team received orders and flew by private jet to London. In mid-flight, agent received news of embassy bombing and proceeded to Landmark hotel with caution. They received a coded message early in the morning, calling for a meeting at the St. Paul's Cathedral. Team made successful contact with Morrigan and was able to evade the authorities searching for her and escort her to the extraction point. Team was given further instructions to follow investigation in Morrigan's stead, starting at her cover identity residence in Northern Ireland. Once in Belfast, team established base of operations and set on Morrigan's apartment. Agents discovered a ransacked home, but were able to locate the hidden data device. Intel from the device yielded a group of suspects, all members of an IRA splinter cell. It also showed a business owned by the main suspect, and team used a combination of stealth and distraction tactics to search the establishment and plant a tap on the phone line. Obtained phone records led team to remote farmhouse, which was well guarded. Agents launched coordinated attack on facility and were successful in subduing all aggressors. The barn at the farmhouse contained a chemical manufacturing facility, and appeared to be the origin of the explosives. Analysis of the facility computer banks yielded forged shipping documents, leading team to the realization that government construction projects in London were at risk of a second, much larger attack. Further search of the farmhouse revealed a taped message from the prime suspect, Shawn Sullivan, speaking of revenge for the death of his father. After cleanup of the farmhouse was completed, team contacted Agency and requested bomb-disarming kits to be waiting on the ground in London, and called for the apprehension of Peter Sullivan and other CIRA members in Belfast. Upon return to London, team split off to check for evidence in the suspected construction sites. Coming up empty at an alternate location, team converged on London Parliament and infiltrated it, finding a bomb of massive size in a back room under Big Ben's tower. Agent team was unsuccessful in its attempt to disarm the bomb, leading to the death of agents Apoc, Famine, and Java. Surviving agents ordered to return immediately to DC for extensive debriefing and evaluation.
