**MISSION BRIEFING:**

Many rogue organizations throughout the world threaten the very existence of mankind in some sort of fashion everyday. One such organization goes by the name of Selenium Sky. This recently assembled terror cell specializes in Selenium-79, a radioactive isotope from spent nuclear fuel, as its weapon of choice in trying to gain power and resources. The Agency has been keeping a very watchful eye on Selenium Sky for some time and has recently intercepted an encrypted message from one of its contacts conveying the transportation of something very important late last night from Australia to Malaysia via a small private aircraft. Malaysian air traffic control has confirmed that the flight never landed and is suspected to have gone down somewhere off the coast of the island of Java, Indonesia. Along with the encrypted message was a series or string of 42 numbers that the Agency believes to be a key of some sort, but to what is unknown. Your mission is two fold. Uncover the location of the aircraft's last position by infiltrating and extracting the radar-tracking log from the air traffic control building located at Halim Perdana Kusuma Airport, and recover whatever was being transported by Selenium Sky from the downed aircraft. Rendezvous with your contact at the designated time and place for further details.

**MISSION DEBRIEFING:**

Mission completed 11:17 pm on 3-24-09.

Agents made their way to the Halim Perdana Kusuma Airport where they received some work clothes and security clearance cards from their contact. The team infiltrated the air traffic control building where they proceeded to bluff and gain access to several key locations throughout the building. A three way infiltration attempt was unleashed where the team finally ended up recovering the radar-tracking log from the airports servers of the downed Selenium Sky plane. The team then proceeded to set sail aboard the Ocean's Edge II Research Vessel through a very nasty storm where they encountered some very large waves and finally make their way to the location of the crash site, which was directly over the Java Trench in the Indian Ocean. Diving down almost 2000 feet in shark infested waters wearing two diving hardsuits; the Agents located the plane's wreckage where they engaged in direct contact with and disabled a third party salvaging ROV before their presence was known. Acquiring a cryptic cipher from the attaché case, the Agents decoded the Selenium Sky code and relayed the message back to the Agency. Another team is being assembled and will be departing to Moscow Russia due to the information revealed from the code.
