MISSION BRIEFING:

The Falkland Islands possible oil cache could greatly alleviate some of Great Britain's, and other supporting allied countries, petroleum oil shortages. Last year, Great Britain has built and positioned three of its four portable oil-drilling platforms off the northern coast of West Falkland Island. In the past two weeks all three British oil-drilling platforms, the Sheffield, the Hampshire and the Bristol have been mysteriously destroyed. All three of the oil platform's underwater support beams were twisted beyond recognition, which in turn, bore the weight of the platform upon itself and led to its collapse. Your mission is to find out who and what is behind the destruction of the British oil-drilling platforms. Your team should go in undercover as a team of oceanographers to the island, so as not to arouse suspicion. You will each be given a FIGAS (Falkland Islands Government Air Service) pass, which will grant you access to and around the island airstrips. One Agency research submarine, the Voltornus II, along with the S.S. Archipelago, her transport ship, will be docked in Port Howard, for the teams use during the mission. Your flight leaves in thirty minutes to Mt. Pleasant International Airport with an ETA of 8:15 AM tomorrow morning. Rendezvous with your contact at the designated time and place for further details.

MISSION DEBRIEFING:

Mission completed 9:22 am on 7-02-07.

Agents went in undercover as oceanographers to the Falkland Islands where they investigated the British oil drilling and fishing community for any relevant information pertaining to the destruction to the oil drilling rigs, just before a British announcement of a possible war was released which escalated the mission's severity ten fold. After hours of submersible prep work, the Agents proceeded to explore the oil drilling rig wreck site where they hypothesized the cause behind the massive destruction. Information was secretly collected, which led to the apprehension and brutal interrogation of the AFR captain of the Manta Ray fishing trawler who, after repeated blackouts, relayed the location to a hidden AFR base camp on Jason Island. Agents proceeded to scale an unsecured 100' cliff to the base camp and engage in a massive melee and firefight battle, consisting of machineguns, handguns and multiple hurled grenades, where they eliminated the entire AFR mercenary camp. A report on submersible PDM technology, which linked the Hikoratachi Corp. to the AFR and the oil drilling rigs destruction, was later found. The Agents proceeded to scan the seas and locate the rouge AFR submarine that housed a PDM Cannon onboard. Both subs engaged in underwater battle, sending multiple torpedoes at each other, damaging the Agent's sub severely, and crippling the AFR sub, sending it 1000' to the ocean floor and the slow painful death to anyone that may still have been alive. After the news release as to who was behind the oil drilling rig disasters, the Agents averted another Falkland Islands war.
