**MISSION BRIEFING:**

As you all know, the Agency tracks all sorts of communications from all over the world and flags certain ones that may contain potential threats to individuals and/or organizations. The Vienna office flagged one such email account, 1f82win@infostrada.com, and an email dump was requested and performed which revealed the shipment of three packages to three very sensitive and public organizations. The Agency believes these packages to be a weapon of some sort but to what extent is unknown. The first package will be arriving today within the hour so there will be no time for mission gear acquisition via the Agency's gear acquisition department. Your mission is to retrieve all three packages without your presence being detected or your covers being blown, and to obtain any information on who may be behind the deliveries. If collection is successful of the first package, your team will be able to acquire mission gear before preceding any further. After which your team will need to split up into two teams to collect the second and third packages as time is of the essence. **MISSION DEBRIEFING:**

Mission completed 12:03 pm on 2-20-10.

Agents made their way to the United Baptist Association. Meeting with their contact and acquiring some helpful aids, they successfully gained access into the organization and located the first package which was a bomb sent from the Angels of Light organization. After disarming the plastic explosive wired to an electronic timer and detonator, the team discovered the first of three encrypted letters from the Angels of Light. Gearing up, the team split up into two teams and made their way to the Roman Catholic Church in Vatican City and the Orthodox Judaism Society in Israel. Gaining access inside each organization, they proceeded to locate and disarm another two plastic explosive devices with encrypted letters inside each package. Rendezvousing at safer locations, both teams started to decipher the letters in hopes of revealing their secrets, which they were successful after some time. The three letters revealed the location of Monroo Island in the South China Sea. The Agency is taking no chances and is reassigning and assembling a new team to investigate.
