MISSION BRIEFING:

The ongoing race to develop the most advanced and sophisticated defensive military electronics and equipment is a race the Agency along with the United States cannot afford to lose. Just yesterday, the United States recovered a Libya mig 23-flogger fighter jet, which appears to have been installed with a U. S. missile guidance-jamming device. The jamming device is manufactured by RTS Frequencies Inc. The company designs and manufactures radar, thermal, and sonar based military electronics and sells them to government militaries. Amir Asanti who is the Executive President of the company oversees all government business contracts and manufacturing. The company is located in Rochester, New York. The facility is highly guarded with some of the latest security systems money can buy. No one knows how the jamming device was stolen or who was behind it. There is no information as to how many jamming devices may have been stolen and sold to foreign countries. This is the first to have surfaced. Your mission is to find out how the U.S. missile guidance-jamming device was stolen along with the persons responsible. Your flight to Rochester, New York leaves in twenty-five minutes. MISSION DEBRIEFING:

Mission completed 7:13 pm on 11/20/06. Agents flew to Rochester, NY and rendezvoused with contact where inside information into RTS Frequencies Inc. were provided to the team, consisting of possible buyers, building security and company personnel. Agents set up head quarters at local hotel when Agents WhiteWolf and Raven were immediately recalled back to the Agency on emergency business. The remaining Agents tried to hack into the highly secured computer mainframe of the company, but to no avail. After a 2-day stakeout, they discovered a late night drop-off of an unknown tubular package in a Fed-Ex drop sight where the Agents used a fiberscope, so as not to produce any unwanted noise, to acquire the shipping address of the package. Agents matched the address of the package, which they believed to be duplicated blueprints of the missing jamming device, to an art gallery in New York, NY and proceeded there the following day. Agents concluded, after combing through the Agency Database, that the owner of the art gallery could be in connection to a murdered Agent in 1999. This fallen Agent was later revealed to be the unknown stepfather of one of the remaining Agents on the mission, in which she later contacted the Agency about her stepfather's last will and testament. Agents arrived at the art gallery and proceeded to survey the area since it's change in 2000. Some careless concealment of Agent weapons caused a security breach in the gallery in which a whirlwind of bullets and lead were fired by French mercenaries and Agents. Many casualties ensued thereafter with a body count of twelve mercenaries riddled with bullet holes and one with his throat almost ripped out from a devastating punch. Agents advanced downstairs to find the art gallery owner, who was repeatedly throttled until unconscious, after he tried to fire his weapon at point blank range at one of the Agents. Four sets of duplicated blueprints from RTS Frequencies Inc. were recovered along with a blood stained knife that was later confirmed to be the weapon in the murder of Agent Athens in a previous cold case after a positive DNA test was ran. Owner was later arrested and charged with 1st degree murder and fifteen counts of international espionage against the United States.

MISSION BRIEFING:

The Agency is led to believe that Karl Bruner, the owner of the "Des Cieux Apercoit" fine art gallery in New York city, is somehow connected with forgery, art smuggling and/or money laundering activities. A couple of well-known paintings from around the world have been discovered to be forgeries. Not all, but some of the paintings have been somehow connected to Karl Bruner's gallery. The gallery denies any and all such allegations. Secrecy is the utmost priority, as any leaks of Agency involvement in this mission cannot be suspected or released to the press. Your mission is to infiltrate the gallery and see if there are indeed any criminal activities being committed, and if so, acquire any information regarding contacts, affiliates and/or money transfers. Rendezvous with your contact at the designated time and place for further details.

MISSION DEBRIEFING:

Mission not completed.

No criminal information was obtained from Karl Bruner or the "Des Cieux Apercoit" fine art gallery. The mission was aborted when the body of the Agent assigned was found washed ashore in lower Manhattan three days later. The New York City police department reported the incident as a mugging or gang altercation, as all money and personal possessions seemed to have been taken. Cause of death was first thought to have been drowning, but later examination revealed multiple repeated stab wounds to the chest and neck region. Obviously, the perpetrator tried to hide the evidence by throwing the body into the bay. No further investigation has commenced.

Agents assigned to Shadow Box mission found Karl Bruner with highly confidential government testing blueprints in his possession along with a blood stained knife that was later confirmed in the murder of Agent Athens. Karl Bruner was finally brought up on charges of forgery, art smuggling and 1st degree murder.
