**MISSION BRIEFING:**

Germany has been one of the leaders in jet propulsion research and development systems for many years. They have been testing new advancements in their Tornado series jet fighters for some time now. Agency sources have revealed that they may in fact have built a manned jet fighter prototype that is capable of sustainable flights of over mach 3.9, which is faster than any jet fighter made today. Unfortunately this one prototype has gone missing and was nowhere to be found, until today. Satellite reconnaissance photos over Germanys small Black Forest Airfield, which is located in the southwest area of Germany, have revealed a possible match to the jet fighter prototype as it was being stored in one of the hangers. Your mission is to fly to the Black Forest Airfield, locate the stolen German Tornado jet fighter and bring it back to the Agency. If retrieval is impossible, your team is authorized to destroy the aircraft by any means possible along with eliminating those responsible for it's abduction.

**MISSION DEBRIEFING:**

Mission completed 10:13 pm on 2-16-08.

Agents made their way to the Black Forest Airfield via a small prop plane where they later made contact with local tower control personnel. After a brief discussion of services with the office manager, the team waited for the tower office to close and proceeded to break into the airfield office and into a locked safe where they obtained three hundred Euros and documentation of the seasonal ownership of the suspected hanger housing the German Tornado IDS prototype. Agents made a surveillance sweep of the area and then began to infiltrate the hanger. Upon a slight miscalculation of trying to sneak into the hanger storage room, Agents engaged in a massive firefight with German militants who were guarding the jet prototype. Agents eliminated all German militant resistance, including bull rushing a German pilot off the top of one of the jet's wings and taking multiple precision shots at escaping militants. After calculating the odds of recovering the stolen fighter jet, the team disabled the Tornado IDS prototype with a well-placed EMP, making sure no one else would be able to use the advanced acceleration module which was the key element of it's increased speed ability.
