ORGANIZATION BACKGROUND: _____

The AFR or Argentine Falkland Régime was formulated after rights of ownership over the Falkland Islands were contested. Was one of the forces that coexisted during and after the Falkland Island War that fought against Great Britain with many political protests and minor altercations. Is thought that the organization is stock piling arms and weapons for a future attack on the Falkland Islands, but no substantial evidence has surfaced. Carlos Morales is the known existing leader of the organization, but to what rank and level is unknown. It is suspected that he may not be the sole leader of the régime, due to his unprofessional political messages and mannerisms that are broadcast over many Argentinean airways. The British government has attempted his capture, but to no avail.

It is known that in the last five to six years, the AFR has grown five times over in the number of recruits and guerilla soldiers that it has enlisted and in turn increased its monetary cash flow ten fold. Where this added funding source is coming from is still unknown, as is the purpose behind it.
