ORGANIZATION BACKGROUND:

Founded in 1992, Selenium Sky has been building power throughout Asia as a biohazard terror cell. Based out of the city of Minsk, Belarus and the surrounding countryside, the rogue organization has been in the development of radioactive isotope production since its creation. Fueling their reign of terror is Selenium-79, which is a radioisotope of Selenium present in spent nuclear fuel and the wastes resulting from reprocessing the fuel. It is one of only 7 long-lived fission products. Its yield is low (about 0.04%) as it is near the lower end of the mass range for fission products. Its half-life has been variously reported as 650,000 years, 65,000 years, 1.13 million years, 480,000 years, and most recently, 295,000 years. Selenium-79 resides as one of the many unstable Selenium isotopes, which can be converted into a very unstable material and later developed into a weapon or a highly lethal radioactive poison.

The Chernobyl disaster in 1986, where 60% of the nuclear fallout landed in Belarus, spawned a rebirth of radioactive warfare spearheaded by Selenium Sky against Russia and any country aligned with the motherland. It has taken the terror cell many years to amass a substantial amount of Selenium-79 in which to terrorize with. Their handiwork or fingerprint has been seen on several occasions throughout Asia and Europe in the past couple of years including employees being exposed to high levels of Selenium radiation at multiple research centers and low profile government facilities, which were first thought to have been accidental. A cover story was released on all accounts to help subdue public interest while a Russian task force was being established to locate and disband Selenium Sky. All attempts of uncovering the organizations whereabouts have failed.

The Agency has been keeping tabs on Selenium Sky since its inception. The Agency believes the biohazard terror cell is very capable of unleashing a large-scale attack at any time anywhere in Asia or Europe, which is why more Agency resources are being assigned to watch over them very carefully in the near future.
