Company started as a small band of oil drillers in the early 1920's and later consolidated into one conglomerate, later to be known as Triton OPEC Corporation. Has gone through some rough times over the last fifty years, trying to stay afloat and not be absorbed by the stronger and more stable Middle Eastern oil refineries. In 1996, Triton OPEC went public on the open market and is one of the few publicly traded oil producing companies and refineries in and around Western Europe. The company is spread out all over the world but its main office is located in the downtown city district of London.

The publicly elected executive board, which oversees almost all shareholder decisions, has reportedly contributed and spent over 2.5 million dollars on oil field research in and around the mid and south Atlantic Ocean region. The company seems to be very optimistic in its endeavors in locating and tapping into newly undiscovered oceanic oil fields and has gone to great lengths in securing the companies drilling rights in that region through legal processes and political negotiations.

The company has seen some backlash and resentment from the Argentinean government and neighboring populous over the last five years in the manor of political protest and national governmental motions and appeals being filed, due to the company's major location and existence around the West Falkland Island. No violent or threatening acts of violence have occurred in that expanse since the end of the Falkland Island War in 1982. The company flourishes to this day.
